All Students

These supplies are for individual student use throughout the year in all classes and should not be dropped off with teachers.

- Folders or binders to organize work for all classes (student choice)
- Spirals/Notebooks for taking notes in all classes (student choice)
- Pencils; 2+ colors of pens
- Highlighters (multiple colors)
- Notebook paper (wide ruled)
- Graph paper (0.25")
- 3x5" index cards
- 6-12" ruler for graphing
- ESV Bible with concordance

Geometry, Algebra I, and Algebra II

- 8.5" x 11" spiral notebook; 100+ page with plastic cover

Calculator Requirements

All students should have and bring a calculator to math and science class daily.

Both types described below are not needed - once you have a graphing calculator a scientific is not necessary.

- Scientific calculator: (useful for all grades) - TI-30XIIS or similar
- Graphing Calculator: TI-84 Plus (any edition) - for Algebra 1 and higher

7th and 8th Grade

- Tracing paper (TX History)
- 3 subject spiral notebook (Science/Health)
- 3 subject wide ruled spiral (English)
- 1 set of earbuds or headphones (NOT WIRELESS)
- 1" binder (Music)

TAPPS-Acting Class

- 1 inch 3-ring Mini binder (black) with page protectors

Art Supplies on back of page

Art (Middle and High School)

All supplies should be clearly labeled for each student

- 1 storage box or bag
 - Should contain all supplies
 - Dimensions approx. 11"w x 14"deep x 7"h to fit in art-room table cubbie
- 1 large spiral bound pad of paper
 - 9"x12" MULTI-MEDIA pad > 80lb
 - May continue using old sketchbook if it fits this criteria
- 1 small spiral bound pad of paper
 - 4"x4" to 9"x5" - something easy to carry
- 6 pencils #2 or HB (not mechanical)
- 1 set 36+ colored pencils
 - Brands recommended: Prismacolor, Faber-Castell, Staedtler
 - Crayola is acceptable but not ideal
- 1 pencil sharpener (small, metal)
- 3 black permanent markers - Sharpie-type
 - 1 fine
 - 2 ultrafine
 - consider a smaller one as well
- 1 set 24+ colored markers - art quality, not Crayola
- 1 set Watercolor paints - art quality, not Crayola
 - One recommended option: <https://a.co/d/h4ZCpir>
- 1 pair scissors, 5" blade or longer
- 1 bottle white PVA glue
- 1 glue stick
- 1 polymer eraser (frequently white)
- 1 - 12" ruler - aluminum with cork back
- 1 pkg post it notes (2"x2", any color)
